Rashes and	
Skin Infections	PERIOD TO BE KEPT AWAY FROM NURSERY
Chicken Pox	Until all vesicles (spots) have crusted over
German Measles	4 days from onset of rash and well enough
Hand,foot and mouth	None – please inform nursery staff
Impetigo	Until lesions are crusted and healed, or 48 hours
_	after starting antibiotic treatment
Measles	4 days from onset of rash and well enough
Scarlet Fever	Can return 24 hours after starting antibiotics

Other infections and	
illness	PERIOD TO BE KEPT AWAY FROM NURSERY
Diarrhoea	48 hours from last episode of diarrhoea
Vomiting	48 hours from last episode of vomiting
Flu (Influenza)	Until recovered
Conjunctivitis	None
Mumps	5 days after onset of swelling
Tonsillitis	None
